He spoke in detail about the South Fire District earning a Class 2 rating by ISO, an increase of its previous Class 4 rating. He explained the comprehensive evaluation process that took place. Beginning March 1, 2025, residents and business owners may be eligible for lower insurance costs. A letter is being drafted to make the residents and businesses in the district aware of this possibility.

The deputy talked about the Safety Cloud transponders and subscriptions service purchased from HAAS Alert. The department purchased two transponders and two subscriptions for service for E32 and T34. The transponders send real-time digital alerts directly to nearby and approaching motorists allowing more time to slow down when approaching emergency vehicles. The goal is to purchase additional transponders for all the apparatus.

Deputy Chief Fischer told the commissioners that he has become a member of the Mayor's Homelessness Task Force.

To all South Fire District Residents and Businesses,

I am very pleased to announce that after a comprehensive evaluation by the Insurance Services Office (ISO), the South Fire District has earned a Class 2 rating, an impressive increase from our previous Class 4 rating. Starting March 1, 2025, residents and business owners of the district may see lower insurance costs because of it.

What exactly is an ISO Rating?

ISO is an independent organization that assesses a community's fire protection capabilities to aid insurance companies in establishing rates for premiums paid by residents and businesses. ISO ratings are determined based on four primary components:

- Fire Department (staffing, training, facilities, and equipment).
- Emergency Communications Systems (911 call center).
- Water Supply System (maintenance of fire hydrants and the amount of water available).
- Community Risk Reduction (efforts to reduce losses through fire prevention, public fire safety education, and fire investigation.

An overall score between 1 and 10 is recorded, with 1 being the best and 10 indicating a department's failure to meet the minimum requirements. Out of about 45,000 fire departments assessed nationally, less than 1,500, or about 3%. receive a Class 2 rating.

What Does This Mean To You?

Not only will this Class 2 rating provide you with reassurance that our staff are doing their very best to protect and serve our community and visitors, but a better ISO rating *generally* means lower insurance premiums. The impact of an ISO score varies by insurer and I encourage you to submit the attached official letter from ISO to your insurance provider to find out if you are eligible for a premium reduction.

A Class 2 ISO rating is truly a community-wide achievement. It's a testament to the expertise and dedication of our staff and the invaluable support we receive from our residents and business owners. It also illustrates the excellent service provided by our mutual aid partners, Middletown's Central Communication Center and Water Department, and the continued support of the city's administration and elected officials.

We wish to thank you and Chief James Trzaski for your cooperation during our recent Public Protection Classification (PPC) survey. ISO has completed its analysis of the structural fire suppression delivery system provided in your community. The resulting classification is indicated above.

If you would like to know more about your community's PPC classification, or if you would like to learn about the potential effect of proposed changes to your fire suppression delivery system, please call us at the phone number listed below.

ISO's Public Protection Classification Program (PPC) plays an important role in the underwriting process at insurance companies. In fact, most U.S. insurers – including the largest ones – use PPC information as part of their decision- making when deciding what business to write, coverage's to offer or prices to charge for personal or commercial property insurance.

Each insurance company independently determines the premiums it charges its policyholders. The way an insurer uses ISO's information on public fire protection may depend on several things – the company's fire-loss experience, ratemaking methodology, underwriting guidelines, and its marketing strategy.

Through ongoing research and loss experience analysis, we identified additional differentiation in fire loss experience within our PPC program, which resulted in the revised classifications. We based the differing fire loss experience on the fire suppression capabilities of each community. The new classifications will improve the predictive value for insurers while benefiting both commercial and residential property owners. We've published the new classifications as "X" and "Y" — formerly the "9" and "8B" portion of the split classification, respectively. For example:

- A community currently graded as a split 6/9 classification will now be a split 6/6X classification; with the "6X" denoting what was formerly classified as "9."
- Similarly, a community currently graded as a split 6/8B classification will now be a split 6/6Y classification, the "6Y" denoting what was formerly classified as "8B."

- Communities graded with single "9" or "8B" classifications will remain intact.
- Properties over 5 road miles from a recognized fire station would receive a class 10.

PPC is important to communities and fire departments as well. Communities whose PPC improves may get lower insurance prices. PPC also provides fire departments with a valuable benchmark, and is used by many departments as a valuable tool when planning, budgeting and justifying fire protection improvements.

ISO appreciates the high level of cooperation extended by local officials during the entire PPC survey process. The community protection baseline information gathered by ISO is an essential foundation upon which determination of the relative level of fire protection is made using the Fire Suppression Rating Schedule.

The classification is a direct result of the information gathered, and is dependent on the resource levels devoted to fire protection in existence at the time of survey. Material changes in those resources that occur after the survey is completed may affect the classification. Although ISO maintains a pro-active process to keep baseline information as current as possible, in the event of changes please call us at 1-800-444-4554, option 2 to expedite the update activity.

ISO is the leading supplier of data and analytics for the property/casualty insurance industry. Most insurers use PPC classifications for underwriting and calculating premiums for residential, commercial and industrial properties. The PPC program is not intended to analyze all aspects of a comprehensive structural fire suppression delivery system program. It is not for purposes of determining compliance with any state or local law, nor is it for making loss prevention or life safety recommendations.







- 1. Monthly Call Statistics sheet is available. Activity for February is approximately 6,286 incidents. Total 911 calls are 1,949 and 6,756 administrative calls.
- 2. Staffing update: currently at 18 Dispatchers as of February 10th. We remain in the process of starting a new hire for certified dispatchers and processing one off the Trainee (non-certified) list.
- 3. The Public Safety 911 Center Building Committee had a meeting on February 27, 2025. This was the first meeting of that Committee. All members were present.
- 4. Process continues with on scene communications for fire department personnel.
- 5. Budget process has started. Meeting with Mayor scheduled for March 10th. Common Council hearing will take place April 16th.
