The City of Middletown Common Council adopted to Defer Tax Payments for (3) months in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order 9R, every quasimunicipal corporation which collects its own taxes, water, sewer or electric charges and is located wholly with in a municipality shall offer the same program or programs that the municipality offers.

What does this mean to the tax payers of the South Fire District?

- (1) From January 1, 2021, supplemental motor vehicle taxes will receive an extended grace period, through and including April 1, 2021.
- (2) Taxpayers must pay all taxes, charges, and assessments deferred in full within (3) months after the original due date. If the taxpayer fails to make payments, all interest, fees and penalties will be applied to all unpaid portions retroactive to the original due date of January 1, 2021.

This program does not address taxes that are already past due. It is not an amnesty or waiver of interest or other charges on taxes that are already delinquent. If you have any further questions please feel free to contact us.
