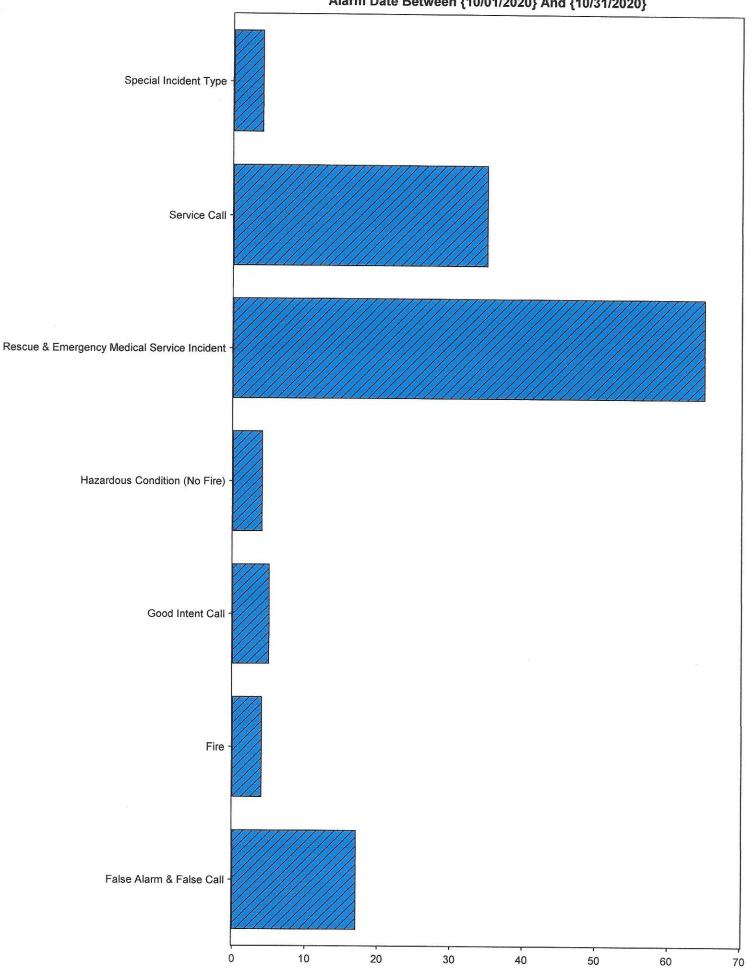

Public Safety Telecommunications Report November 2020

- Monthly Call Statistics sheet is attached. Activity for October is approximately 4,900 incidents, approximately 2,033 911 calls and about 9,050 administrative calls.
 - a. Telephone activity over the past six months has averaged 11,600 calls per month which is high. The last month to do that is July 2019 and then July 2018.
- 2. EMD Report August 95.21%.
- Staffing update; Current 19 Full 21. We have a Dispatcher Trainee position filled from within City work force and is in training. That position started 11/2.
- 4. COVID We remain diligent at dispatch concerning this issue and all available and practical precautions are in place.
- 5. The interface to the State radio network has performed extremely well and given Middleton and Portland Police coverage never expected. There has been no down time with this system or ours. We have shared our system with other state assets as well. An example is units that patrol and monitor Wadsworth Park use our system. Also Durham, Haddam and Middlefield Fire are frequently on our system.
- 6. Special thanks to the Middletown Fire personnel for their hard work in completely renovating the former EOC. They went thru that room top to bottom. We will share that room for much badly needed conference and training space. It is equipped with a 10' conference table, projector, TV and all necessary wifi and phone options. This was desperately needed and I can't thank them enough.
