- 4. Staffing update; Staffing is at 16 and full staffing is 21. We have 3 conditional offers out pending backgrounds. 1 Certified and 2 trainees. We have two trainers and myself that will train the individuals once they start. Training should take 3-4 months for the certified dispatcher and 4-6 months for the trainees.
- 5. Director will be going for an appropriation for overtime funds in February.
- 6. No update on Mile Lane Cell Tower from AT&T.
