Present: Commissioners Kleckowski, Giuliano, Pessina, and Thazhampallath (arrived at 7:05 p.m.); Chief Trzaski, Deputy Chief Fischer (via Zoom), member of the public, staff members

Absent: Commissioner Gregorio

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Kleckowski called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE was recited.

3. ACCEPT/AMEND AGENDA

MOTION to accept the agenda without changes by Comm. Giuliano/Comm. Pessina. Unanimously approved.

4. OPEN PUBLIC SESSION – ITEMS ON THE AGENDA

Chairwoman Kleckowski opened the public session at 7:04 p.m.

Dan Penney

Mr. Penney is concerned that Building Committee meetings are not being held and asked who approves change orders. He said that minutes from previous Building Committee meetings have never been posted. Mr. Penney mentioned that meetings of the By-Laws Committee are public meetings and need to be appropriately posted and should include public participation. He asked if proposed changes would go to referendum. Mr. Penney inquired about various charges shown on the Monthly Expense Detail report, including \$48,125.23 to CNR, and expressed his feeling that such a large expense should be pre-approved by the commission. He asked for clarification of what H & H under line item 7711B stands for.

5. CLOSE PUBLIC SESSION Chairwoman Kleckowski closed the public session at 7:08 p.m.

6. MINUTES TO BE ACCEPTED

a. Regular Monthly Meeting of August 12, 2024

The minutes were accepted as presented.

7. TAX COLLECTOR'S REPORTS - AUGUST 2024

a. Refunds: \$3,593.04

MOTION to accept refunds in the amount of \$3,593.04 by Comm. Thazhampallath/Comm. Giuliano. Unanimously approved.

b. Acceptance of the Tax Collector's Reports

MOTION to approve the Tax Collector's Report by Comm. Giuliano/Comm. Pessina. Unanimously approved.

8. FINANCIAL REPORTS

- a. Monthly Expense Detail: May and June 2024; July and August 2024 Chief Trzaski answered questions raised during the public session. H & H stands for "heart and hypertension."
- b. Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual: July 2023 through June 2024; July 2024 through August 2024
- c. Cash Balance Report: June 2024; August 2024

The financial reports were accepted as presented.

9. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS - AUGUST 2024

Chief Trzaski and Deputy Chief Fischer provided an overview of the administrative reports and answered questions of the commissioners. They spoke of the FMO's school inspections and fire prevention week programs, joint training with Middletown FD and Westfield FD at an acquired structure on Eastern Drive, meetings with Kleen Energy and Middletown Station to discuss response and operating plans, and South Fire District's involvement during the Naugatuck Valley flooding. The chiefs also elaborated on the restructuring of the radio system in collaboration with Central Communications. Deputy Chief Fischer advised the commission that Chief Trzaski is the recipient of the Middlesex County Chamber of Commerce's 2024 "Chief Michael L. Green Award, presented annually to a member of the police or fire community for his or her outstanding service to the community and to the Middlesex Chamber of Commerce, and the Connecticut Fire Department Instructors' Association's 2024 President's Award, presented annually to individuals who best represent the organization and the fire service as a whole. The deputy gave accolades to South Fire District, Portland FD, and Middletown FD for the support they provided for the tragic boat accident in Old Saybrook.

Chief Trzaski informed the commission about Public Act 24-16, "an act concerning authority to declare that a firefighter, police office, or emergency medical service personnel died in the line of duty." A copy of the Act is attached to these minutes. The commission unanimously agreed that the determination should remain with the chief.

10. COMMISSIONER REPORTS

- a. Building Committee: Commissioner Thazhampallath
 - Commissioner Thazhampallath gave a brief update about the renovation project. Unexpected obstacles caused delays in the progress. A committee meeting is scheduled for September 12th at 6:00 p.m.
- b. Pension Committee: Commissioner Gregorio (absent)

Chairwoman Kleckowski indicated that a committee meeting will be held in October.

c. Public Safety Telecommunications: Commissioner Giuliano

Commissioner Giuliano provided an overview of the submitted report. The Common Council approved the \$10 million dollar bond for a new dispatch center, which will go to taxpayers in November.

d. By-Laws Committee: Commissioner Giuliano

MOTION to allow the chairman of the By-Laws Committee to obtain professional services to assist in reviewing the by-laws by Comm. Pessina/Comm. Thazhampallath. Commissioners Kleckowski, Thazhampallath, and Pessina voted in favor. Commissioner Giuliano abstained.

e. Riverfront Redevelopment Update: Commissioner Pessina

Commissioner Pessina provided a brief update on Tate's Restaurant.

12. NEW BUSINESS

a. Economic Development Updates – Middlesex Health Care is being looked at and Dairy Queen on South Main Street is moving forward.

Mr. Penney asked for the annual audit update and recommended that the public be permitted to provide input. Substitute House Bill No. 5279

Public Act No. 24-16

AN ACT CONCERNING AUTHORITY TO DECLARE THAT A FIREFIGHTER, POLICE OFFICER OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PERSONNEL DIED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 7-313e of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2024*):

(a) Notwithstanding any provision in the general statutes or a municipal ordinance to the contrary, the fire chief of the municipality, or any member serving in the capacity of fire officer-in-charge, shall, when any fire department or company is responding to or operating at a fire, service call [,] or other emergency, within such municipality, have the authority to: [(a)] (1) Control and direct emergency activities at such scene; [(b)] (2) order any person to leave any building or place in the vicinity of such fire for the purpose of protecting such person from injury; [(c)] (3) blockade any public highway, street [,] or private right-of-way temporarily while at such scene; [(d)] (4) at any time of the day or night, enter any building, including a private dwelling, or upon any premises where a fire is in progress or near the scene of any fire, or where there is reasonable cause to believe a fire is in progress, for the purpose of extinguishing the fire or preventing its spread; [(e)] (5) inspect for the purposes of preventing fires and preplanning the control

of fire all buildings, structures or other places in their fire district, except the interior of private dwellings, where any combustible material, including, but not limited to, waste paper, rags, shavings, waste, leather, rubber, crates, boxes, barrels or rubbish, that is or may become dangerous as a fire menace to such buildings, structures or other places has been allowed to accumulate or where such chief or [his] such chief's designated representative has reason to believe that such material has accumulated or is liable to be accumulated; [(f)] (6) order disengagement or discouplement of any convoy, caravan or train of vehicles, craft or railway cars for the purpose of extinguishing a fire or preventing its spread; and [(g)] (7) take command of any industrial fire brigade or fire chief when such fire company or department has been called to such industry.

(b) If the death of a uniformed paid or volunteer firefighter is caused by a cardiac event, stroke or pulmonary embolism that occurred not later than twenty-four hours after such firefighter concluded a shift or training, the chief of such firefighter's fire department shall have the authority to determine whether such firefighter died in the line of duty, unless a local charter or ordinance in effect on October 1, 2024, provides the authority to a different individual or entity to make such determination. Such declaration by a chief shall not be used as evidence for a workers' compensation claim under chapter 568.

Sec. 2. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2024) (a) For purposes of this section, (1) "police chief" means the chief law enforcement officer of a law enforcement unit, the chief elected official of a municipal police department without a chief law enforcement officer or, in the case of the Division of State Police, the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection, and (2) "law enforcement unit" and "police officer" have the same meanings as provided in section 7-294a of the general statutes.

(b) If the death of a police officer is caused by a cardiac event, stroke

or pulmonary embolism that occurred not later than twenty-four hours after such officer concluded a shift or training, the police chief of such officer's law enforcement unit shall have the authority to determine whether such officer died in the line of duty, unless a local charter or ordinance in effect on October 1, 2024, provides the authority to a different individual or entity to make such determination. Such declaration by a police chief shall not be used as evidence for a workers' compensation claim under chapter 568 of the general statutes.

Sec. 3. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2024) If the death of any emergency medical service personnel, as defined in section 19a-175 of the general statutes, is caused by a cardiac event, stroke or pulmonary embolism that occurred not later than twenty-four hours after such personnel concluded a shift or training, the service chief, or other administrative head, of such personnel's department, service, company or emergency medical service organization, as defined in section 19a-175 of the general statutes, shall have the authority to determine whether such personnel died in the line of duty, unless a local charter or ordinance in effect on October 1, 2024, provides the authority to a different individual or entity to make such determination. Such declaration by a chief or administrative head shall not be used as evidence for a workers' compensation claim under chapter 568 of the general statutes.

Please see the attached Fire Marshal activity report for the month of September 2024.

The FMO attended seminars on mitigating hoarding in residential occupancies and fatal fire arson investigations. The seminars credited the office with twenty hours of continuing education. We are required to obtain ninety hours every three years. Both events were well attended and provided great networking opportunities.

The FMO assisted the Durham Fire Marshal by inspecting various mobile food vendors at the Durham Fair. This not only aided one of our mutual aid partners, but was also a learning experience for the office in a low frequency type of inspection.

The FMO participated in community outreach programs at the Falcon's Club and at the Rec Center. We were able to meet with members of the public, conduct safety demonstrations and provide fire prevention literature.

The FMO met with the Firesetter Committee at CVH in order to develop a proposal for the International Association for Firesetting Intervention, Research and Education. The key focus of the proposal is to address the barriers of the fire service and the mental health community working together. If accepted, the FMO, along with clinicians from CVH, will be presenting at the 2025 conference.

The FMO finalized all planning and logistics for the 2024 Fire Prevention Week. School visits, the Open House and the Fire Prevention Poster Contest will all take place during the week of October 6. We anticipate interacting with over 1,000 people during this week.







Public Safety Telecommunications Report October 2024

- 1. Monthly Call Statistics sheet is available. Activity for September is approximately 7,025 incidents. Total 911 calls are 2,298 and 7,764 administrative calls.
- 2. Staffing update: currently at 16 Dispatchers fully certified. One Trainee started August 26th. A certified Dispatcher started September 23rd. One conditional offer for Trainee is pending in the process. We will be training three at once pending background and physical on last position.
- 3. The Bond at \$10M will be on the November ballot. Council dropped the proposal for a lower amount. Special thanks to behind the scenes work of Gene Nocera and others in public view such as Commissioner Seb Giuliano, UPSEU President Ann Gregg and several Union Local 466 members. The Public Safety Chiefs from PD and FD have been great during this process.
- 4. In September we conducted in-house training on medical emergency program updates and local FD procedures for the staff. Each year we do two in-house training sessions and one major training session where we bring in a national program. In October there is a one day session that is a national program for Advanced Fire Dispatch.
- 5. The Deputy Director is working on updates that are part of our service agreement with Motorola. We just completed a new 4 year renewal agreement as our last is expiring. The agreement is \$426,341 for this FY. Over the 4 year period the total is approximately \$2.125M. This is critical to our radio infrastructure for the entire City.
- 6. The Mayor's Office is working on procedures for City Board and Commission members. I will be sending out some information that is provided to all Board and Commission members;
 - Power point training on freedom of information and ethics (22 slides)
 - Ethics Ordinance
 - Charter provisions for Boards and Commissions
