1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Kleckowski called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

3. ACCEPT/AMEND AGENDA

4. OPEN PUBLIC SESSION – ITEMS ON THE AGENDA

Chairwoman Kleckowski opened the public session at 7:04 p.m.

Dan Penney

Mr. Penney remains very concerned about changes to the bylaws related to voting rights and commissioner qualifications. Regarding voting rights, he indicated that fire districts are not totally exempt and there are different interpretations about what the district can and cannot do. He asked the commission to research the subject. Mr. Penney asked the commission to be cautious in the budget promotion/mailed by keeping the information on the mailed limited so public funds are not being used to promote the budget.

John Killian

Mr. Killian, a member of the By-Laws Revision Committee, commented on the proposed changes made related to voting and believes the wording gives everyone an opportunity to cast a ballot, especially with the use of absentee ballots. He is in favor of the change that allows a firefighter from a different town the opportunity to serve on the commission. He thanked the committee for their teamwork on the revisions.

The deputy reminded the commission of the citywide mass casualty exercise taking place on 4/15 and 4/16 which will involve South Fire District, Middletown Fire Department, Middletown Police Department, and several other public agencies. The deputy and members of the Boat Committee will be traveling to Canada new week to review the specs. The new boat will take 6-7 months to build and will not be put in service until next season. The Police Department is allowing the district to use one of their boats for this season.

Chief Trzaski spoke about a lesson plan prepared by DFM Parmelee for Beman Middle School's STEAM Program involving different types of machines. The lab portion will take place at SFD headquarters. Additionally, as a result of the fire marshals' involvement in the adult fire setting training at Whiting Forensic Hospital, they have been invited to present at the *2025 IFIRE Conference on International Perspectives on Child and Adult Fire setting: Advances in Research and Practice*. The conference will be broadcast throughout the world.

DC Fischer and Training Captain Turenne organized a mock DUI incident for the juniors at Xavier High School on 4/25/25. The Middletown Police Department, Life Star, Middlesex Hospital, Hunters Ambulance, and possibly Biega's Funeral Home will also be involved. The chief reported that Kleen Energy recently purchased a trailer that holds 500 gallons of foam concentrate to be used on site.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Kleckowski called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

3. BUDGET WORKSHOP

Chief Trzaski and Deputy Chief Fischer provided an overview of the proposed budget and answered questions of the commissioners. Chief Trzaski said it is very unlikely we will be able to collect motor vehicle taxes due to the city's proposed 32.8 mill rate and the State of CT 32.46 mill rate cap on motor vehicles. However, we are fortunate that the PILOT funding has increased from \$710,000 to \$879,971. Martin Heft, OPM Undersecretary of Intergovernmental Policy & Planning Division, confirmed the PILOT funds are in the state's current budget. The chief sent him an email asking for reconfirmation. The challenge is that we won't receive the funds until October.

The increase in the proposed budget is \$352,637, without CNR. The increases are mainly due to insurance premiums, salaries, contractual obligations, and worker's compensation insurance. He suggested excess PILOT funds be put into CNR to start funding apparatus replacement and other big-ticket items. PILOT funding is a result of many years of not receiving reimbursement for service to CVH. The commissioners agreed that it is fiscally responsible to invest any excess PILOT funding in CNR while we have the opportunity since the state has a two-year budget and it is unknown what will happen when it expires.

The commissioners were pleased with the proposed budget at this point.

The budget workshop ended at 6:23 p.m.

2025 – 2026 Budget Notes

Income

Motor Vehicle Property Tax Revenue and Tax Supplement – This calculation is estimated based on the Common Council's approval of the proposed **32.8** mill rate and the State of Connecticut motor vehicle **32.46** mill rate cap, therefore NOT allowing South Fire District to collect motor vehicle taxes.

Investment Income – a conservative increase due to the increase in interest rates on unrestricted funds.

Expenses

7201 – Electricity – Estimated increase due to building renovation. Heating is electric in the new addition.

7202 – Water & Sewer – Increase based on usage.

7203 – Heating – Estimated decrease due to building renovation. Heating is electric in the new addition.

7204 – Telephone – Increase due to increase in service cost.

7403 – Vehicle Repairs – Increase due to aging apparatus.

7403-1 – Apparatus Preventative Maintenance – Increase due to increase in service costs.

7404 – NFPA/OSHA Compliance – Increase due to additional OSHA requirements being imposed.

7501 – Insurance – Workers Compensation – Increase primarily due to an increase in our Experience Modification Rating, which considers factors like payroll, claims history (over 3 years), and industry-specific data. A 1.00 EMR is developed when there are the average number of expected claim dollars paid and has no effect on the premium. Our rating increased from .87 to 1.04.

7502 – Insurance – Commercial Package – Increase due to standard industry increases.

7503 – Insurance – Medical – Increase due to staffing and family status changes based on current premiums. An estimated increase of 7% has been used for the period of 01/01/2026 – 06/30/2026 as recommended by our carrier.

7504 – Insurance – Cyber – Increase due to standard industry increases.

7509 – Insurance – Life and Disability – Increase due to salary increases.

7512 – Pension – Defined Contribution – Increase due to staffing changes, salary increases, and possible minimal increase in employer contribution.

7513 – Unused Sick Time – Increase due to staffing changes.

7601 – Salaries – Fire Department – Increase due to staffing changes and salary increases.

7602 – Salaries – Administrative – Increase due to salary increases.

7603 – Replacements/Call Backs – Calculated based on overtime hours in previous fiscal year and using new salary rates. *As of the payroll of May 1st we are currently at \$530,427.55 which is 74.9% of budget. When underfunding this line, it also affects the following:*

- 7609 – Employer – Social Security
- 7610 – Employer – Medicare
- 7501 – Insurance - Workers Compensation – Each year we submit our expected payroll for our worker's comp carrier to provide a quote for the next fiscal year. However, when audited annually and we are over the expected payroll, we are billed for the difference.

Unfortunately, we cannot anticipate emergencies, illness, or injuries. Regardless, it is fiscally irresponsible to underfund this line. This causes a strain on the rest of the budget and makes it more difficult to operate within our lines.

7604 – Fringe Benefits – Increase due to fringe benefits paid associated with salary and staffing changes.

7607 – PEB – Heart and Hypertension – Increase due to possible claims.

7609 – Employer – Social Security, and 7610 – Employer – Medicare – Increase due to salary increases, and increase in 7603 – Replacements/Call Backs.

7701 – Tax Collector's Expense – Increase due to increase in vendor service cost.

7702 – Professional Org/Periodicals – Decrease due to change in professional memberships and fees.

7703 – Office Expenses – Increase due to increase in average expenses.

7704 – Auditor – Estimated increase due to State Single Audit required when expending state grant funds in excess of \$500,000.

7709 – Activity Expense – Increase due to increased participation in activities/events.

7710 – Professional Services – Increase due to anticipated entry level and promotional exams, as well as legal fees.

7712 – Office Equipment – Increase due to anticipated equipment needs.

7717 – Software Support – Increase due to increase in software and support.

7802 – Supplies Maintenance – Increase due to increase in average expenses.

7803 – Services – Increase due to increase in service costs.

7909 – Uniforms – Estimated. Current increase due to price some quotes received and one new firefighter.

7910 – Protective Clothing – Decrease due to one-time replacement of rescue helmets in FY 24-25.

7911 – Communications – Increase due to anticipated radio replacement.

7912 – Cell Phones – Increase in service cost.

7915 – Medical Testing – Increase due to NFPA 1582 physical requirement and one new firefighter.

7916 – Breathing Apparatus Test & Repair – Increase due to increase in repairs.

3. PUBLIC HEARING

Dan Penney

Mr. Penney requested a copy of the organizational chart and would also like to see a detailed spreadsheet on CNR. He indicated that even though the auditor recommends having 6 months of reserves, which was previously 3 months, the monies could be used to offset some of the expenses. Although there is no increase in the mill rate, there is more than an 8% increase in spending. Mr. Penney would like to have an estimate of the impact the new Collective Bargaining Agreement has on the budget. He suggested commissioner compensation be removed from the budget. Mr. Penney mentioned that the newer equipment should be under warranty resulting in additional savings. He mentioned that some fire districts are created through special acts and others are statutory districts and suggested that the commissioners look into the difference.

Commissioner Gregorio responded by saying he would never agree to get rid of commissioner compensation. Receiving a stipend makes them employees of the district preventing them from being personally sued. Commissioner Giuliano added that if the commissioners weren't legally covered by the district, they would be compelled to purchase elected official coverage, which is very expensive. Commissioner Pessina agrees that the compensation should not be eliminated.

Subject: Vote of Yearly Suspense

In Compliance with Section 12-165 of the Connecticut General Statutes, I hereby submit a list of Personal Property and Motor Vehicle tax bills, which I deemed to be uncollectible at the present time and request your approval to transfer these items to our Suspense Tax Book as of June, 2025. Items transferred to suspense are removed from consideration as assets of the district, but not abated as a tax liability of the person against whom it was levied. The tax office continues to collect money owed on these accounts for 15 years, per State Statute Sec. 12-164, *tax uncollectible after fifteen years. Interest on improvement liens. (a) No payment of taxes shall be enforced by any collector or other proper officer against any person, persons or corporation against whom they are respectively levied except within fifteen years after the due date of tax.*

All suspense items are entered into our automated tax system, Quality Data Systems, and are submitted to the Department of Motor Vehicle along with our entire delinquent list. By submitting the list of delinquent accounts to the DMV, any future registrations of these delinquent motor vehicle accounts, including suspense, will not be processed at the DMV until the monetary obligations to the South Fire District are satisfied.

Motor vehicles submitted for suspense are presently not registered in Middletown, and/or the individual or business which the registration indicates cannot be located. Personal Property accounts or either out of business or no longer living in Middletown and are not on the subsequent Grand List. These accounts have been sent to our collection agency for collection in an attempt to collect the amount that is due.

I have suspended bankrupt accounts that are deemed uncollectable from the 2008-2022 Grand List years. I did not suspend any accounts that match names on the 2023-2024 Grand List.

This year's suspense is \$9,528.84 which is an increase of \$1,589.71 from last year. This fiscal year the collection agency was able to collect from past accounts \$7,168.77 which started on 7/1/2024. The fee that the collection agency charges is passed on to the taxpayer, so the district does not incur any expense.

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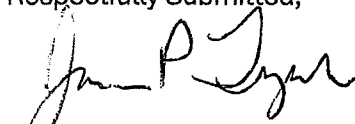

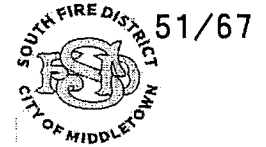

Public Safety Telecommunications Report
May 2025

1. Monthly Call Statistics sheet is available. Activity for April is approximately 6,752 incidents. Total 911 calls are 1,942 and 7,421 administrative calls.
2. Staffing update: Currently at 18 Dispatchers. We are processing one candidate off the Trainee (non-certified) list and also hiring a part time custodian. Both should be filled by July 1st.
3. The Public Safety 911 Center Building Committee did not have an April Meeting. We are waiting on the results of the RFP package for Architectural and Engineering Services as well as the report from soil testing at the site.
4. The Fire Departments new on scene communications is now in effect. This will provide maximum fire ground safety for personnel in terms of on scene communications.
5. Central Communications has participated in an active shooter drill on April 15th and 16th. This was a large scale drill and the Deputy Director has been in the planning stages for the past several months. As you can imagine it involves all emergency services in Middletown. Many dispatchers attended and participated in the drill.
6. Budget FY 25-26 process is at the Common Council level for final disposition. I do not expect changes for the Central Communications Center.
