

Please see the attached Fire Marshal activity report for the month of August 2024.

The FMO attended the annual Public Fire and Life Safety Educator Conference at the Connecticut Fire Academy. One of the major themes was utilizing the Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) approach to engaging youth. Underwriters Laboratories has partnered with the Fire Service in developing many free videos and programs utilizing this concept. We look forward to reaching out to the STEM program at Beman and incorporating what we learned.

The FMO conducted Fire and Life Safety Inspections in all the schools in our jurisdiction. Facility managers are working on repairs for the violations that were found. No major code violations were observed, but there was a trend in extension cord overuse. Specifically with coffee machines and refrigerators. We have brought this to the attention of the administration for each school and educated them on electrical safety.

The FMO has contacted most of the vendors and guests that typically attend the annual Open House. In addition to our own apparatus and demonstrations, there will also be the vaccination clinic, vision screening and multiple activities for children. The FMO will provide fire prevention literature and giveaways related to this year's theme of Smoke Alarms Make Them Work for You.

The FMO continues to work with the new owner of 49 Randolph Rd. The owner is moving a well-established soccer program to the lot. We have had several meetings about future tenants in the existing building, as well conceptual meetings about the prospective new fields. There will be both indoor and outdoor fields for four seasons of play. We are excited for this program to be in our district and the influx of consumers to other local businesses.

# Public Safety Telecommunications Report September 2024

- 1. Monthly Call Statistics sheet is available. Activity for August is approximately 7,115 incidents. Total 911 calls are 2,317 and 7,354 administrative calls. The most increase is due to a motor vehicle law enforcement grant to stop vehicles.
- Staffing update: currently at 16 Dispatchers fully certified. One Trainee started August 26<sup>th</sup>. Two conditional offers are out to applicants. We will be training three at once pending background and physical exams.
- 3. On August 19<sup>th</sup> the Common Council decided to approve our \$10 million dollar bond issue for a new Dispatch Center. Since then It was further decided to reduce the amount to \$8.9M. That proposal to reduce was voted down at the September 3<sup>rd</sup> Council meeting. The \$10M bond now goes to taxpayers in November.
- 4. In October we will be conducting training for the staff. Each year we do two inhouse training sessions and one major training session where we bring in a national program. This one day session from the national program is Advanced Fire Dispatch. We will also doing an in-house program on our medical emergency program and local FD procedures.
