- 1. CALL TO ORDER Chairwoman Kleckowski called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.
- 2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE was recited.

3. ACCEPT/AMEND AGENDA

Motion to accept the agenda as posted by Comm. Giuliano/Comm. Thazhampallath. Unanimously approved.
