**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING
APPLICATIONS FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTS
FEBRUARY 1, 2021 COMMISSIONER ELECTION**

All eligible South Fire District electors may apply for an Absentee Ballot for the February 1, 2021 Commissioner Election (Annual Meeting). **Applications** for Absentee Ballots can be obtained from the South Fire District website, <https://www.southfiredistrict.com/news/application-for-absentee-ballot-february-1-2021-commissioner-election/>, or in person at the firehouse by calling Chief Howley at 860-347-6661 to schedule an appointment.

Official Absentee Ballots will be available beginning January 22, 2021.

It is highly recommended the above steps be taken as soon as possible to ensure all Absentee Ballots are received by the following deadlines: **in person** – no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 29, 2021; **by mail** – no later than 8:00 p.m. on Monday, February 1, 2021.

In-person voting will take place on February 1, 2021; however, in order to protect the health and safety of the electors and SFD staff, voting by Absentee Ballot is strongly encouraged.

Pursuant to the South Fire District By-Laws, the Legal Notice for the Election/Annual Meeting, including detailed election information, will be published on January 22, 2021, posted on the South Fire District website and on the SFD Facebook page.
