

# **SOUTH FIRE DISTRICT of the City of Middletown**

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

A Special Meeting of the Electors of the South Fire District will be held on Tuesday, July 21, 2020, at 8:00 p.m. at the Firehouse via Zoom (<https://us02web.zoom.us/j/88923873215> - Meeting ID 889 2387 3215). The purpose is to elect one Commissioner to fill a Commissioner vacancy, commencing at 12:00 noon, July 22, 2020. The term for this position is only until the February 2023 SFD Annual Meeting.

Voting will be between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. As a result of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, eligible voters will cast their ballots at a vehicle drive-thru style election at the Firehouse, 445 Randolph Road, Middletown, CT. Voters will be asked to show proof of identification. Details of the drive-thru voting can be found on the South Fire District's webpage, [www.southfiredistrict.com](http://www.southfiredistrict.com), and Facebook page.

Absentee Ballots are available to qualified registered voters of the South Fire District by taking the following steps (revised process due to COVID-19 pandemic):

- Fill out an “[Absentee Ballot Application, Form ED-3 Rev. 5/2019](#)”; *OR*
- Fill out an “[Emergency Application for Absentee Ballot, Form ED 3E Rev. 8/99](#)” (to be used *ONLY for those who apply for an absentee ballot because of an unforeseen illness or physical disability occurring within 6 days before the close of the polls, or because they are patients in a hospital within such 6 day period*).
- Mail completed and signed applications to South Fire District, 445 Randolph Road, Middletown, CT 06457. An official absentee ballot will be mailed to you; *OR*
- Hand-deliver completed and signed applications to the fire house, by appointment only.
- Applications and/or Absentee Ballots can be picked up from or hand-delivered to, the fire house by calling 860-347-6661 to arrange for an appointment.

Absentee ballots must be received by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, July 20, 2020, in person by appointment, or by 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 21, 2020 by mail in order to qualify to be counted. Due to the revised absentee ballot process, it is highly recommended that the above steps are taken as soon as reasonably possible to ensure all ballots are received according to the deadlines in order to be counted.
