

JUNE 16, 2025 REFERENDUM VOTING RESULTS

At a referendum of the South Fire District, two questions were submitted to qualified registered voters of the district.

Question 1: Shall the proposed budget for fiscal year July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026 of \$8,072,855 with a mill rate of 5.311 for real estate and personal property, as recommended by the South Fire District of the City of Middletown, be approved?

A total of 354 votes were counted, including twelve absentee ballots. Voting results were as follows:

Question 2: Shall the South Fire District By-Laws be revised in accordance with the recommendations of the By-Laws Review Committee, and approved by the Board of Fire Commissioners?

A total of 351 votes were counted, including twelve absentee ballots. Voting results were as follows:

The by-laws referendum achieved the required two-thirds vote of the electors (234 votes). Commissioner Giuliano declared the by-laws revisions have been adopted.
